


# St Peter's Eastern Hill Klingner Scholarship Application 2018



**Purpose:** The Klingner Scholarship was founded in 1975, in memory of Harold Edgar Klingner, to support members of the St Peter's Guild of Servers or "other suitable candidates" in training for Holy Orders.

Applications are welcome from those who are presently, or soon to be, training for the diaconate and priesthood at one of the following theological colleges: Trinity College, Melbourne; St Barnabas College, Adelaide; or St Francis College, Brisbane.

**Amount:** the Klingner Scholar will be awarded \$8,000 for one year with the right to reapply.

**Criteria:** it is expected that the candidate will:

- be a member of the St Peter's Eastern Hill Guild of Servers, and on the parish roll of St Peter's Eastern Hill, **or** on the parish roll of another parish within the Anglo-Catholic tradition.
- **and/or** connect with St Peter's Eastern Hill in some agreed way over the course of the year of study.
- have been accepted by the Diocese of Melbourne, or another Australian Diocese, as a candidate in training for Holy Orders, or be actively involved in a Diocesan discernment programme.
- be enrolled at one of the three theological colleges listed above.

**Application Process:** the applicant must submit the following:

- Completed application form
- Letter of application addressed to the Klingner Scholarship Committee. The letter should contain a brief statement providing biographical information (e.g. church involvement, brief work history) and a summary of future plans.
- Letter of nomination from the applicant's parish priest or a member of the Anglican Church with significant knowledge of the applicant's experience and involvement.
- Academic transcript of previous degree(s) or other tertiary study undertaken.
- A 500 word essay addressing the topic:  
*"Discuss the Problems and Opportunities for Anglo-Catholicism Today"*

**Deadline:** all Klingner scholarship applications are to be submitted by **Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2017**. Applications sent after this date will not be considered.

- Refer to criteria above for eligibility requirements.
